I William Womble, of the County of Wake
and State of North Carolina, being of Sound mind
and memory, but considering the Uncertainty of my
Earthly Existence, do make ~~and~~ declare this my last
Will and Testament, in manner and form
Following, that is to say - first that my Executor,
herein after named, shall provide for my body
a decent burial suitable to the Wishes of my relations
and friends, and pay all funeral Expenses, to
gether with my Just debts, however and to Whom
soever owing out of the moneys that may first
come into his hands as a part or parcel of my
Estate, Item, - I give and devise to my beloved
Wife Priscilla Womble, a certain parcel of land
during her natural life, including the dwelling
House and all other out house, and plantation
whereon I now live, for her own use and
benefit, and I also give and devise the said
plantation, dwelling house & all other houses
appertaining there to, to my ^{3^d} Wife as before
stated and also the same to the use my three
single Daughters now living with me, during
their natural life, or so long as they may live
single, and for no longer a time, the names
of those three Daughters of mine are as follows
to wit Martha Womble, Elizabeth Womble, & Priscilla Womble

The House and plantation that I have give and
revised do affore said to my Wife and three
Singel Daughters, as where ^{last} to fore named, -
is bounded as follows, Begining at Thomas,^s
Creek, in Thomas Womble,^s line, thence up a
Spring branch to Elmerott Womble,^s Corner,
thence up the said branch to the Widow William
Larkley,^s line, Thence up said line to Thomas, B,
Barker,^s line, thence with S^d Barkers line &
others Down to Thomas,^s Creek, ~~by a Red oak~~
Which is my Cornner, Thence Down S^d Thomas,^s
Creek to the begining, this in cludes my dwelling
house & other improvements, to have and to hold
to her my said Wife Prisciler Womble for and
during the term of her natural life; in Satisfac
tion for, and in lieu of her Dower, and thirds
of and in all my real Estate, and also the
Same to my three Daughters as before named
during there natural life, or as long as they
may remain Singel, and know longer,
I further give and devise to my beloved wife
Prisciler Womble, The following property for
and during her natural life, To wit,
~~the~~ Choice horse, and all my Stock including
Cattle, hogs Sheep, and Fowels, of Every discription

I further more give and devise to my beloved
Wife Priscilla Womble, all of my Stock of
Provisions now on hand or that may be on
hand at my Death, Even including Every Thing
of that kind, such as Corn, Wheat, meat,
lard, Fodder, oats, &c, &c,

I also give and devise to my Wife Priscilla
Womble, all of the House hold and Kitchen
furniture, during her natural life, and no
longer, I also give and devise to my Wife
Priscilla Womble What Farming Utentials she
may see Cause to keep, at my Death,

it is further my wish and desire that
my three single Daughters as heretofore named
shall have the use of the said property &
provisions, that I have give & devised unto
my 3^d Wife, With her, my said Wife, during
my said Wife's natural life, and know longer
that is so far as the perishable property is con-
cerned, or as long as they my Daughters may
remain single, and have ^{the} use of the 3^d property
know longer, It is further more my will and
desires, that after taking out what property
I have given of heretofore named that the
Remainder if any be sold by my Executor,

Further it is my will and desire, after the Death of my beloved Wife Priscilla Womble, that all of my property be sold, and the moneys arising from such sale to be Equally divided among all of my children here after named, according to what may be coming to them respectively after there rendering a schedule of what they have had here to fore, it is my desire that a schedule be rendered by each one of all they have had of me during my life, so that one and all can fare and share a like, it is not my desire that one should have more than a nother, ~~there~~ it is my desire that they all have Equal Shares, The Names of my children are as follows To Wit,

Womble, and lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty Friend and Son William H. Womble my lawfull Executor, to all intents and purposes, To Execute this my last Will and testament, according to the true intent and meaning of the same, and Every part and Clause thereof - here by declaring Utterly Void, all other Wills and testaments by me heretofore made, In Witness Whereof, I the said William Womble, do here unto set my hand and seal this 7th day of April A.D. 1852,
