Leffly's company Third regiment of Rifles who was enlisted the twenty seventh day of April eighteen hundred and fourteen to serve during the war, is hereby honorably discharged from the army of the United States, having faithfully served out the full period of his enlistment.

Said Samuel Mann was born in the County of Northampton in the State of North Carolina is about twenty two years of age, five feet seven inches high, light complexion, blue eyes, light hair, and by occupation, when enlisted, a farmer.
